The Feldbach History

1252	Kuno von Feldbach makes a donation consisting of the Feldbach castle, several fields and vineyards to a sister's congregation of Constance.
1253	Abess Sophia and 20 sisters move to Feldbach. They adopt the strict rules of the nuns of the Cistercian order.
1452	Dating of the altar of the nunnery church, kept nowadays at the historical museum in the Frauenfeld castle.
1525 - 1549	After the reformation, very few nuns still live at the nunnery. A bailiff takes care of the administration on behalf of the Swiss confederation.
1552 - 1580	The abbess Afra Schmid revitalises the nunnery.
1761	20 women and 6 nuns are registered.
1798	Decline of the nunnery.
1832	The St. Nicholas chapel on the lake-shore is demolished.
1836	The government takes care of the administration of the nunnery, despite the resistance of the nuns.
1848	The canton abolishes the nunnery, the remaining 8 canonesses, 4 nuns and 3 novices as well as some clergymen must leave.
1849	The municipality of Steckborn buys the plot of land, the church and the buildings of the nunnery.
1846 - 1869	Labhart Bros establish a steam-powered sawmill in Feldbach. They also manufacture rifle stocks. The Sawmill burns down in 1869, the company leaves.
1869 - 1881	The foundry Gubler-Labhart, also manufacturing embroidery-machines, settles in the nunnery. The foundry is set up in the former conventional church.
1881	Steinemann Co. and the locomotive factory Winterthur rent the rooms.
1886 - 1916	Karl Friedrich Gegauf sets up an embroidery work and a factory for embroidery machines in the refectory.
1894 - 1916	Samuel Bächtold opens a foundry and a motor factory in 1894.
1895	July 24th, the buildings of the nunnery and the church burn down. The refectory and buildings in the southern part escape the fire. Bächtold Co. build new halls.
1918 - 1919	Rieter Co. establishes a factory that builds machines to produce bricks and for packaging.
1925 - 1974	Production of rayon in Feldbach. The company has more than 1000 employees.
1976	The confederation, the canton, the municipality, the local and the school authorities buy the whole area, in a joint venture with Gegauf Co.
1980	Opening of the new boat harbour, space for 270 boats.
1981	Opening of the new sports and multipurpose hall.
1986	Opening of the training centre and hotel Feldbach.
1994/95	Enlargement and renovation of the Lake Hotel Feldbach.
June 1995	Re-opening of the „Lake & Park Hotel Feldbach“...a small oasis of hospitality and cosiness – an alluring opportunity to retire, to relax and to be inspired by.
